

## **Gazebo - Building Permit Application Checklist**

<u>Note:</u> All applications must provide sufficient information to show that the proposed work will conform to the Alberta Building Code and whether or not it may affect adjacent properties.

## Please submit the following:

- Permit Application
  - Signature
  - Mailing Address
  - Contact Number
  - o Email Address
  - o Payment Method

- Blue Sign/Fire Number, Civic Address, Legal Description and/or Land Location
- Project Value
- Detailed Description of Work
- Development Permit (if required by the Municipality. Check with your local jurisdiction)
- Site Plan showing the location of the proposed construction, property lines, dimensions, adjacent buildings and/or structures, utility locates, north arrow, etcetera
- Foundation Details
- Plan / construction details including dimensions and roof details
- Building Elevation drawings with dimensions and cross-section views (all 4 views: front, back, and sides)
  - photos are acceptable
- Additional Information as required

## **NOTES**

- $\star$  A gazebo, permanent or temporary, exceeding  $10\text{m}^2$  requires a building permit.
  - This building permit requirement includes permanent structures that are covered with partial or complete side openings.
- ★ In accordance with the Permit Regulation Section 3, a permit is not required for a tent (temporary fabric covered structure) on land zoned residential and for residential / personal use.
- ★ Complete site locates prior to construction to ensure safe construction and placement of structures as various codes contain regulations pertaining to construction near or over utility services
