
Solid Fuel Burning Appliance - Building Permit Application Checklist

Note: All applications must provide sufficient information to show that the proposed work will conform to the National Building Code-Alberta Edition and whether or not it may affect adjacent properties.

Please submit the following:

- Permit Application
 - Signature
 - Mailing Address
 - Contact Number
 - Email Address
 - Payment Method
 - Blue Sign/Fire Number, Civic Address, Legal Description and/or Land Location
 - Use of Building where unit is placed
 - Detailed Description of Work
- Development Permit *(if required by the Municipality. Check with your local jurisdiction)*
- Floor Plan / layout drawing(s) drawn to scale showing the placement of the appliance, clearances to adjacent walls, and what non-combustible material the appliance will be placed on *(such as tile, stone, concrete etcetera)*.
 - must indicate location of carbon monoxide alarm
- Copy of the Manufacturer's Installation Specifications
- Reference to or photo of unit certification
- Additional Information as required

NOTEWORTHY ITEMS

- ★ Includes wood or pellet burning stove or fireplace
- ★ A WETT inspection is not part of your building permit application or associated with building code requirements.

- ★ Photos may be required to be submitted during installation of the appliance.
